



JUDAS BETRAYS JESUS

¹⁴ Then one of the Twelve—the one called Judas Iscariot—went to the chief priests ¹⁵ and asked them, “What are you willing to give me if I deliver him over to you?” So they counted out for him thirty pieces of silver. - Matthew 26:14-15 (NIV)



JESUS ACCEPTS HIS CROSS

²⁷ Then the governor's soldiers took Jesus to the Praetorium and gathered the whole company around him. ²⁸ They stripped him and put a scarlet robe on him, ²⁹ and then twisted together a crown of thorns and put it on his head. They put a staff in his right hand. They bowed before him and mocked him. “Hail, King of the Jews!” - Matthew 27:27-29 (NIV)



JESUS FALLS FOR THE FIRST TIME

¹⁷ Carrying his own cross, he went out to the place of the Skull (which in Aramaic is called Golgotha). - Matthew 27:33 (NIV)



JESUS MEETS HIS MOTHER, MARY

²⁴ When Jesus saw his mother there, and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to her, “Woman, here is your son,” ²⁷ and to the disciple, “Here is your mother.” From that time on, this disciple took her into his home. - John 19:26-27 (NIV)



VERONICA WIPES THE FACE OF JESUS

“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. This is the love that remains in us, so that everyone will know that we have loved one another.” - 1 John 13:1 (NIV)



JESUS FALLS FOR THE SECOND TIME

²⁹ Those who passed by mocked him, shaking their heads and saying, “You who destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross now!” - Matthew 27:39 (NIV)



JESUS MEETS THE WOMEN OF JERUSALEM

²⁷ A large number of people followed him, including women who mourned and wept for him. He turned and said to them, “Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for me; weep for yourselves and for your children.” - Matthew 23:37 (NIV)



JESUS FALLS FOR THE THIRD TIME

Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.” - Luke 23:34 (NIV)



JESUS IS STRIPPED OF HIS CLOTHES

“They crucified him. Dividing up his clothes, they cast lots to see what each would get.” - Matthew 27:35 (NIV)



JESUS IS TAKEN DOWN FROM THE CROSS

⁴⁷ Now when evening had come, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who himself had become a disciple of Jesus. ⁴⁸ This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. Then he took the body and wrapped it in a clean linen cloth. ⁴⁹ - Matthew 27:57 (NIV)



JESUS IS LAID IN THE TOMB

⁵⁹ When Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, ⁶⁰ and laid it in his new tomb which he had hewn out of the rock. - Matthew 27:60 (NIV)



JESUS IS RESURRECTED

“Don’t be alarmed,” he said. “You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who has been raised from the dead. He is not here.” - Matthew 28:5 (NIV)
