

DANCING GEORGE WASHINGTON.



By properly attaching the legs and arms to the body you will have the complete figure of Washington. Then fasten a string to the top of his head and, being limber-jointed, he will dance when the string is shaken. This mark (o) indicates the spots where round holes should be made, through which small rivets may be passed to hold the parts together. Certain uniform marks are placed on the ends of the joints belonging together. Cut out and paste on pasteboard, which must be shaped like the pattern.
