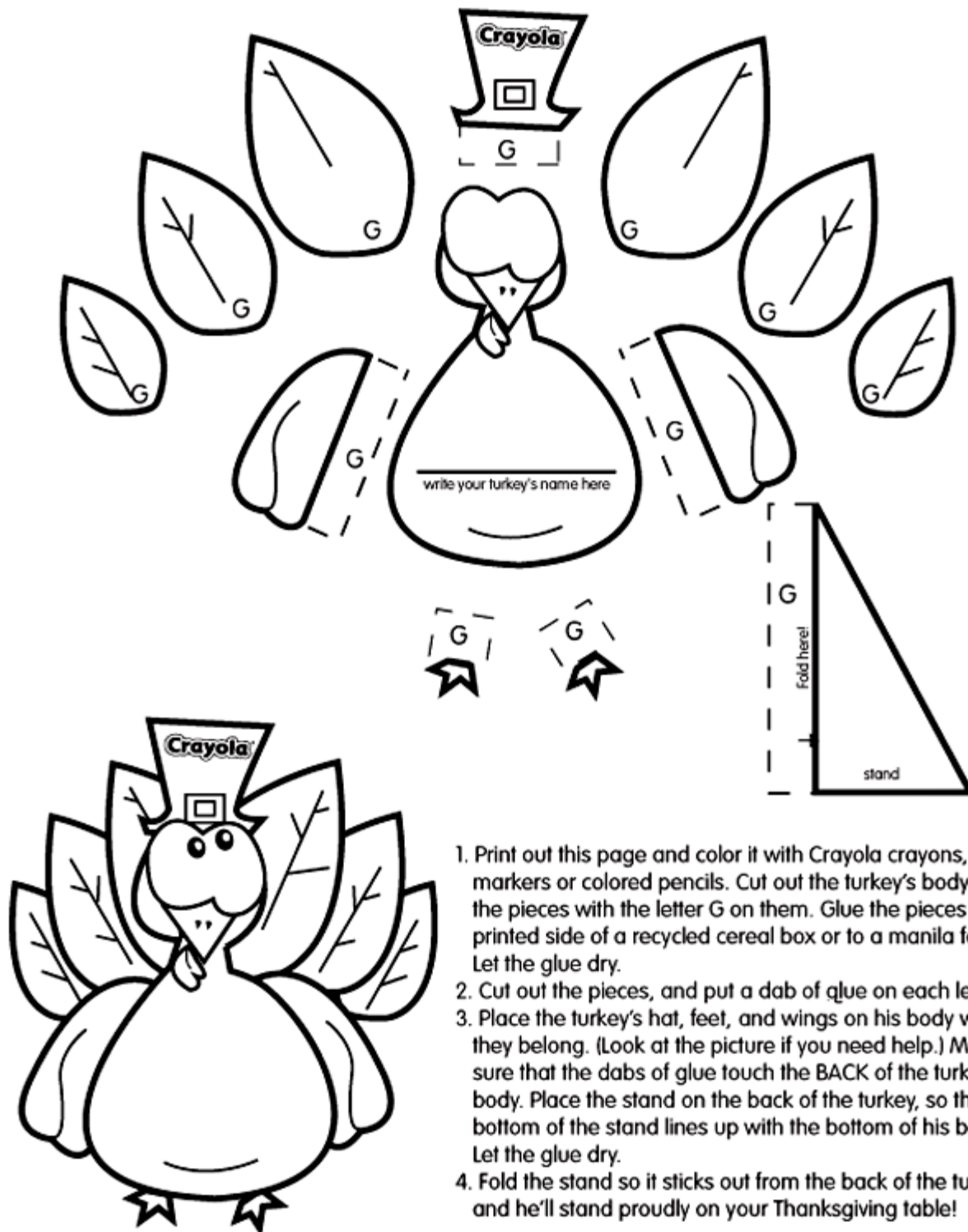


Make Turkey Tom a Friend!



1. Print out this page and color it with Crayola crayons, markers or colored pencils. Cut out the turkey's body and the pieces with the letter G on them. Glue the pieces to the printed side of a recycled cereal box or to a manila folder. Let the glue dry.
2. Cut out the pieces, and put a dab of glue on each letter G.
3. Place the turkey's hat, feet, and wings on his body where they belong. (Look at the picture if you need help.) Make sure that the dabs of glue touch the BACK of the turkey's body. Place the stand on the back of the turkey, so the bottom of the stand lines up with the bottom of his belly. Let the glue dry.
4. Fold the stand so it sticks out from the back of the turkey, and he'll stand proudly on your Thanksgiving table!
