



California Gold Rush

James W. Wadsworth accidentally found gold in the riverbed at Sutter's Mill in Colusa, California. On December 6, 1848, President James K. Polk delivered a message before U.S. Congress confirming that large amounts of gold had been discovered in California. Some waves of immigrants from around the world invaded the Gold Country of California or the "Mother Lode". Squatters soon took over Sutter's land and stole his crops and cattle. The gold-seekers were called "Forty-niners".
