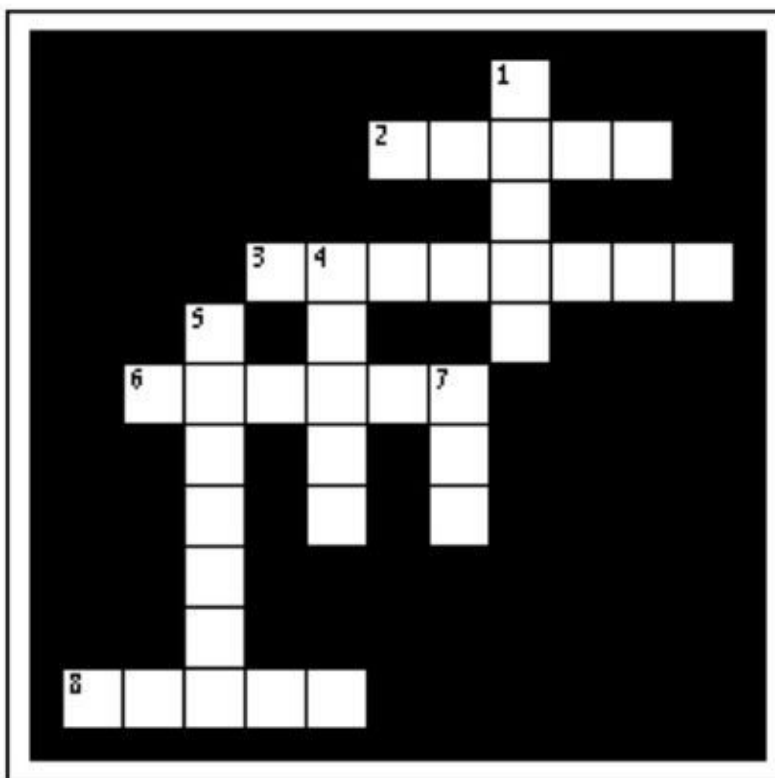


## 48. THE LORD SENDS QUAIL (NUMBERS 11:4-14, 31-34)



- 5 DOWN "For the drunkard and the \_\_\_\_\_ will come to poverty, and drowsiness will clothe a man with rags." **PROVERBS 23:21**
- 7 DOWN "The children of Israel also wept again and said, 'Who will give us meat to \_\_\_\_\_?'" **NUMBERS 11:4**
- 8 ACROSS They said, "But now our whole being is dried up; there is nothing at all except this \_\_\_\_\_ before our eyes!" **NUMBERS 11:6**
- 1 DOWN "The people went about and gathered it, ground it on millstones or beat it in the mortar, cooked it in pans, and made \_\_\_\_\_ of it." **NUMBERS 11:8**

- 3 ACROSS "And the people stayed up all that day, all that night, and all the next day, and \_\_\_\_\_ the quail." **NUMBERS 11:32**
- 6 ACROSS "But while the meat was still between their teeth, before it was chewed, the wrath of the LORD was aroused against the people, and the LORD struck the people with a very great \_\_\_\_\_." **NUMBERS 11:33**
