



Flag of Germany - Bundesflagge und Handelsflagge

Adopted on 23 May 1949.

A horizontal tricolour of black, red, and gold. The colours of the modern flag are associated with the republican democracy formed after World War I, and represent German unity and freedom. The black-red-gold tricolour first appeared in the early 19th century and achieved prominence during the 1848 Revolutions.
