Adopted on September 27, 1949. Designed by Zeng Liansong.

A large golden star within an arc of four smaller golden stars, in the canton, on a field of red. The red represents the communist revolution; the five stars and their relationship represent the unity of the Chinese people under the leadership of the Communist Party of China.
