



The most common dinosaur during the late Jurassic period was the **Allosaurus**. This two-ton predator was thirty-six-feet long and stood sixteen-feet high. It had powerful legs and hands

that had three fingers with six-inch-long claws. Fossils were found in North America, Tanzania, and Australia.
