



7. Seabiscuit. The subject of a bestselling book and an acclaimed motion picture, Seabiscuit was a grandson of the great Man O' War. Born in 1933, he displayed his heritage of speed and toughness by becoming the first horse to top \$400,000 in win-

nings. Of the 89 races he entered, the horse earned 33 wins, 15 second places, and 13 thirds. His defeat of War Admiral in a 1938 match race ranks as one of the greatest victories in American racing history.
