Play dominoes. Make your own set of dominoes using D words. First, make a list of words that begin with D. Cut out domino-sized pieces from construction paper or thin cardboard. Then either write a D word on each half of the domino piece, or draw a picture, using Crayola® crayons or washable markers. Repeat the words or phrases often enough so there are matches when you play.



Nursery rhymes and songs are loaded with D sounds. Try "Hey-Diddle, Diddle" or "Doe, Ray, Me." Make up playful poems and songs with words that begin with D.
