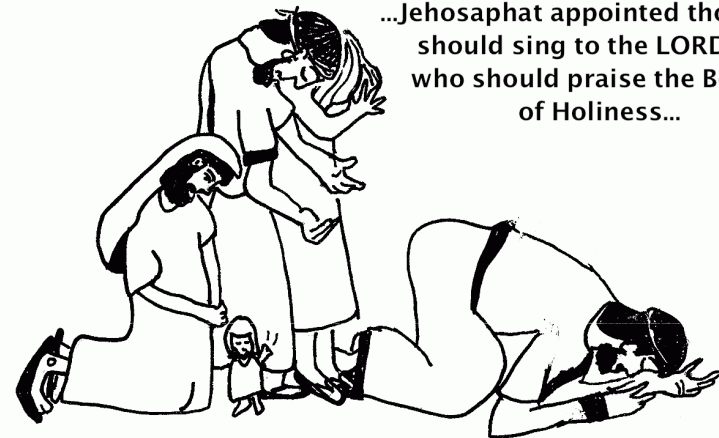


"We will be

Many years later he faces a large enemy army but he is quick to seek the LORD; indeed, all of Judah gathered together "...And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with his face to the ground, and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem bowed before the LORD..."

(Edom) who had come against Judah; and they were
