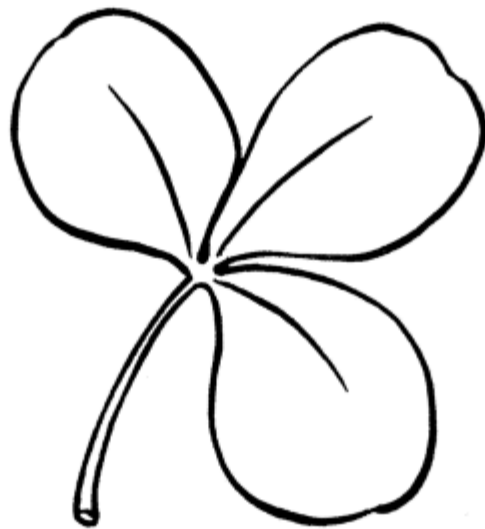


The Shamrock

as a metaphor for the Christian Trinity, according to legend.
The name shamrock is derived from Irish seamróg,
