



- The raven, a member of the crow family, is an intelligent bird and is an "opportunistic" eater – feeding on carrion, garbage and even picnic lunches if you don't watch them close enough
- Ravens mate for life.
- The birds lay clutches of 4 to 7 green spotted eggs.
- The raven is called "Crow" by First Nations people and is a character in many traditional stories.
- The raven was adopted as the Yukon's official bird in October 1985.
