

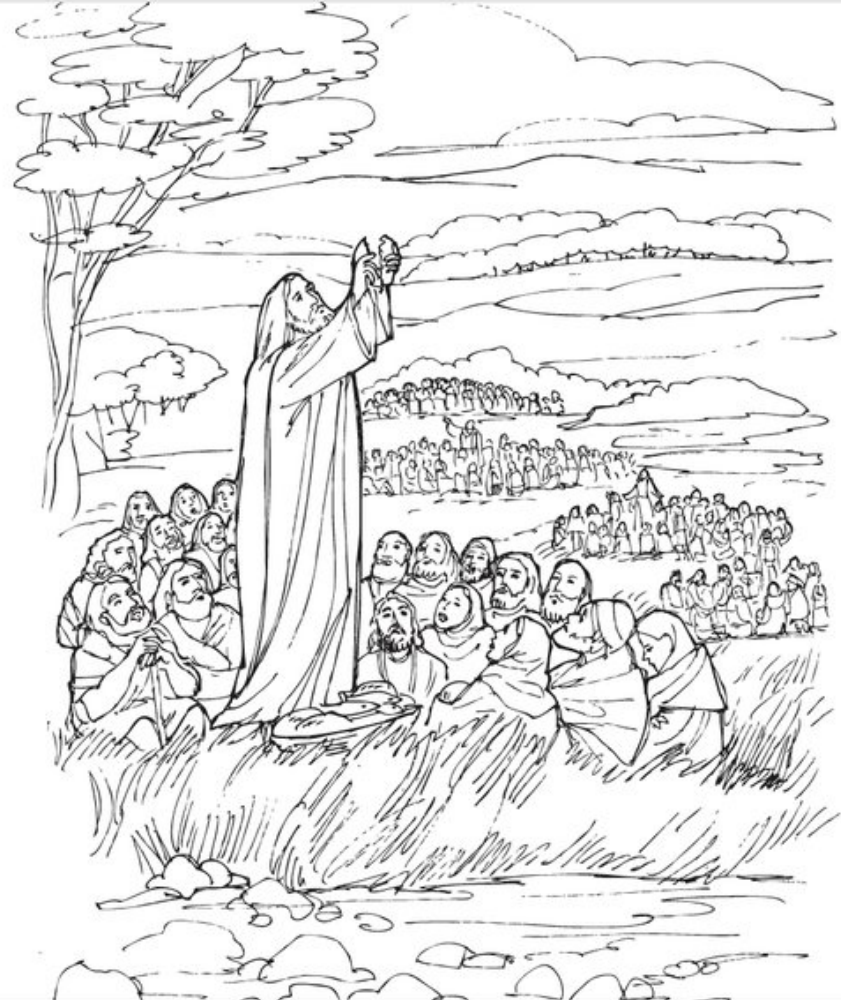


MESSIANIC FULFILLMENT: Luke
