Scorpion



<u>Coloring Instructions</u>: Color the scorpion's body light brown. It's claws, legs, and tail should be yellowish-brown.

Interesting Fact: Scorpions were one of the very first kinds of arachnids. In Florida, scorpion stings feel like wasp stings and are not considered life threatening. Scorpions prefer to hide under leaves or other dark, secure places. When camping, shake out your shoes in the morning to make sure a scorpion isn't taking a nap inside.
