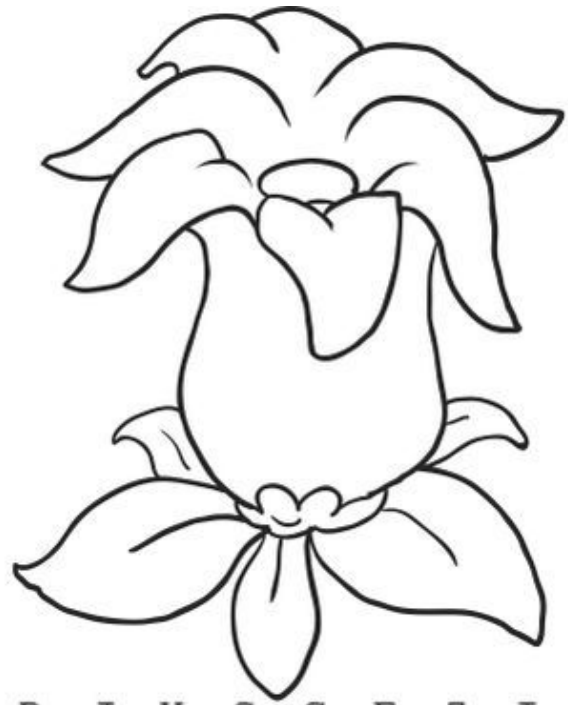


Tulip

Tulips belong to the Liliaceae family of flowers. Flowers from this family have six petals in two rows going up. Some flowers of this type only grow in groups sometimes sharing root systems. Others like the tulip are flowers that are solitary. They usually have long stiff leaves that are at the base of the plant. Plants in the Lilaceae family are primarily ornamental but a few are vegetables.
