

SHAPE-MATCHING CARDS

The following shapes are suggested for use with primary or special education groups who are studying the concept of diversity. They are utilized to help a group focus on what is around them. They may also be used to distinguish shape from size. (Children tend to identify a similar shape only if it is also the same size as their shape card.) The entire group may work together to find the same shape, or individuals can work to find their own shape.

Shapes can be cut from construction paper which is covered with contact paper on both sides. This successfully preserves and waterproofs the shapes.
